Part 1

Borough Library

- §101. Library Established. A free public, non-sectarian library shall be established and maintained in the Borough of Emporium, the cost of establishing and maintaining the same to be paid by appropriations made by the Council of said Borough. (Ord. 87, 1/7/1929, §1)
- §102. Tax Rate. A tax at a rate not exceeding one (1) mill on the dollar on all taxable property in the Borough of Emporium, to be used in the payment of the cost of establishing and maintaining said library shall be levied and collected annually. (Ord. 87, 1/7/1929, §2)
- §103. Board of Library Directors. The affairs of said library shall be under the exclusive control of a Board of Library Directors to be composed of six (6) members who shall be appointed by the Council with the approval of the Mayor for the term of three (3) years; provided, however, that two (2) of the first appointments shall be for a term of one (1) year, two (2) shall be for a term of two (2) years and two (2) shall be for a term of three (3) years, all appointments thereafter shall be for a term of three (3) years. Vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired term. No member of the Board shall receive any salary for his services as such. (Ord. 87, 1/7/1929, §3)
- §104. Transfer of Emmanuel Public Library. The Board of Library Directors is authorized to accept the offer of Honorable Josiah Howard to transfer Emmanuel Public Library to the Borough of Emporium, and to accept any other donations to the library or subscriptions to the library fund. (Ord. 87, 1/7/1929, §4)
